School of Biological and Chemical Sciences 4-year Excellence and Merit Scholarships

BSc in Biotechnology & BSc in Genetics and Genomics

Eligibility requirements:

- 1. All applicants must apply as full fee paying Non-EU students.
- 2. If students are in receipt of any other outside scholarship, they are ineligible for the SBCS Excellence or Merit Scholarship.
- 3. Applicants should have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 80% for Merit Scholarships and 85% for Excellence Scholarships to be eligible for consideration for the scholarship. Each applicant must provide a certified transcript/GPA or other official transcript as evidence of these grade requirements.
- 4. The applicant must complete the entire application process required by the University of Galway, including providing all documentation requested in the application or otherwise requested by the Programme.
- 5. The applicant must attend the specified BSc programme during the next academic year (AY2025/26). Scholarships cannot be deferred.
- 6. The student must pass all modules and progress to following year to be eligible for subsequent annual scholarship awards. Limitation of 4 years, without Leave of Absence except in exceptional circumstances.

Selection criteria:

The Programme Director/ Programme Board is responsible for selecting the SBCS Excellence and Merit Scholarship recipients. The Programme Director/ Programme Board shall base its selection of Excellence Scholarship recipient on the following:

- 1. **Eligibility.** Each SBCS and Merit Excellence Scholarship recipient shall meet all the eligibility requirements described above.
- 2. Objective and Non-discriminatory Selection Procedure. The Programme Director/ Programme Board shall select the SBCS Excellence Scholarship and Merit Scholarship recipients who, in the view of the Programme Director/ Programme Board, are the most deserving of scholarship awards based upon the objective criteria described below. The Programme Director/ Programme Board shall select the SBCS Excellence and Merit Scholarship recipients on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, without regard to gender, race, religion, national origin, or disability.

- 3. **Applicant Personal Statement/Essays.** The Programme Director/ Programme Board may but is not required to request SBCS Excellence and Merit Scholarship applicants or candidates to submit personal statement/essays on topics relevant to the Programme.
- 4. **Objective Criteria.** The Programme Director/ Programme Board may consider only the following objective criteria in selecting the SBCS Excellence and Merit Scholarship recipient:
 - a) Prior academic performance.
 - b) Participation in college, extracurricular, community activities and prior work experience.
 - c) Recommendations from undergraduate or research supervisors.
 - d) Conclusions that the Programme Director/ Programme Board draw from a Personal Statement/Essay submitted in the application process that demonstrate the applicant's motivation, character, ability, and potential.
 - e) Financial need, with an emphasis toward providing scholarships to a student with financial need, but to whom other need-based assistance is unavailable.
